## Download and use Picasa

### What's it all about?

One of the many tools that you can get from Google is **Picasa**.

You can get it free from Google. You can use it to upload pictures to the Picasa web albums and also to copy digital photos from your camera to your computer, organise your photos and make slide shows. You can even edit photos, cropping them to different sizes, making them lighter or darker and dealing with the dreaded "red-eye".

### Downloading Picasa

Go to [www.picasa.google.com](http://www.picasa.google.com) and click Download Picasa (3.6 is currently the latest version but that could change)



On the next 2 boxes, click Run to start the download.

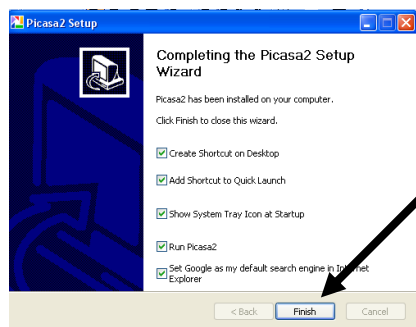


Now click I agree to accept the License Agreement

On the next box, click Install to install Picasa on your computer and finally,

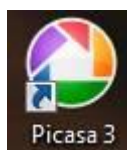


Click Finish to complete the Setup Wizard.
